

**STOP WORK WARRANT FOR FIRE, HEALTH, AND SAFETY CODE VIOLATIONS
(TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE 352.022)**

THE STATE OF TEXAS to any Fire Marshal of Van Zandt County, Texas, who has responsibility for the inspection of any specified premises to determine the presence of a fire or health hazard or unsafe building condition or a violation of any fire, health, or building regulation, statute, or ordinance in the territorial limits of Van Zandt, Texas:

WHEREAS, the affiant whose signature is affixed to the affidavit supporting the issuance of this warrant is a Fire Marshal under the laws of the State of Texas and did therefore this day subscribe and swear to said affidavit before me, which affidavit is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference for all purposes, and whereas I find that the verified facts and information contained therein and stated by affiant are sufficient to establish probable cause for the issuance of this warrant.

NOW THEREFORE, you are hereby commanded to enter upon suspected place and premises described in said affidavit and to there order all parties involved to temporarily stop work until such a time that all State fire codes are met, and the Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ) has reviewed and approved all required documents. At such time as the required codes are met, the AHJ shall issue a permit and work shall be allowed to commence. Herein fail not, but have you then and there execute this warrant within three (3) days, exclusive of the day of issuance and exclusive of the day of execution, with your return showing how you executed same.
